STEP 1

STEP 2

Candidates must then complete this application in full. All applications must be submitted by email to <u>volunteer@fpcanada.ca</u> by November 14, 2025. Applications submitted after the deadline will not be considered.

STEP 3

The Board Development Committee will carefully review and assess all applications against the position profile and will select a short list of candidates for further consideration.

STEP 4

The Board Development Committee will conduct interviews with the short list of candidates (by videoconference) in January or February 2026 and recommend the new appointment to the Board in February or March 2026.

STEP 5

The Director's first term will begin in June 2026, however the Director may be invited to join the March Board meeting as a guest.
